L. N. Mithila University Offers Postgraduate Degree in the following subjects under Choice Based Credit System (C.B.C.S.) spread over four semesters.

### 1. Admission to P.G. part-I (First Semester)

**1.1** A candidate seeking admission to above courses must be have passed the Bachelor Degree with Honours in the subject concerned or as a subsidiary subject or as a subject in pass course or in an allied subject. Preference will be given to those having passed with the Honours as a Subject/Major subject/Core course.

**1.2** In such subjects where candidates with Honours/Pass degree are not available, students having degree in allied subjects may be treated at par as having Honours Degree in the subject.

**1.3** Admission to P.G. Part-I (First semester) shall be made in order of merit. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the applicant in the PET (Postgraduate Entrance Test) examination organized by the University.

**1.4** In the subject where number of applicants will be less than the number of seats in that case the merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the applicant in the Bachelor Degree course.

## 2. Eligibility Criteria

**2.1** The eligibility criteria to apply for admission to Postgraduate (first semester) are as follows:-

- (i) Passed the Bachelor degree with 45% marks in respective Honours Subject/Major Subject/Core Course  
or
- (ii) Passed the Bachelor Degree with 55% marks in Subsidiary/Pass Course/Allied Subject.

### **2:2 Structure of the entrance test:**

Questions shall be of multiple choice type with four options having a single correct answer. The entrance test shall be held on OMR sheet. The duration of the test shall be of 2:30 hours. The total marks will be 200. There shall be no negative marking. There shall be two parts in the question paper as mentioned in Table-1.

In General Aptitude Test questions will be asked from

- i) Numerical Reasoning test.
- ii) Questions based on Statistics, Figures and Charts.
- iii) Diagrammatic tests.
- iv) Situational Judgment test.
- v) Error Checking test and
- vi) Others.

**2.3** The application fee including admission test fee to P.G. courses will be Rs. 750/- only. This will include the fee for admission test.

### **4. Reservation of Seats**

- 4.i** The reservation of seats in each course shall be as per reservation rules of the Government of Bihar.
- 4.ii** A maximum of two seats in each subject over and above the sanctioned seats shall be filled by applicants who have distinguished themselves in sports. (Under this category only those applicants shall be considered who have represented their university/State in different disciplines at state/national level events), Fine Arts (Under this category only those applicants shall be considered who have represented their University in different disciplines at state/national level events), NCC-C Certificate holders, and NSS Certificate holders representing University/ State.
- 4.iii** Reservation for sons/daughters/spouse of Military personnel/Defence Personnel will be followed as per provisions of the General ordinance for Admission to Various Courses received from the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar, Patna vide its letter no.

PU18/99-3944/GS(I) date 28.08.1999. This reservation will also be over and above the normal sanctioned strength of the subject.

- 4.iv** Reservation for sons/daughters of respective University teachers will be followed as per provisions of the General Ordinance for Admission to Various Courses received from the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar, Patna vide its letter no. PU18/99-3944/GS (I) dated 28.08.1999. This reservation will also be over and above the normal sanctioned strength of the subject.
- 4.v** Reservation for sons/daughters of respective University non-teaching staff will be followed as per provisions of the General Ordinance for Admission to Various Courses received from the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar, Patna vide its letter no. PU18/99-3944/GS(I) dated 28.08.1999. This reservation will also be over and above the normal sanctioned strength of the subject.
- 4.vi** 2% seats of the sanctioned strength in any subjects may be filled with NRI/Foreign students. These seats will be treated as over and above the normal sanctioned strength. NRI candidates under this category shall submit their applications duly recommended by M.E.A. (Ministry of External Affairs) alongwith the copies of the documents showing NRI status.
- 4.vii** A candidate seeking admission under various reserved category i.e. SC/ST/EBC/OBC/WBC/EWC etc. has to mention about the category at the time of on-line submission of application form the candidate must submitted the supporting document to substantiate his/her claim at the time of counselling.
- 4.viii** A candidate seeking admission under special quota as mentioned above 4.ii to 4.vii shall have to mention category at the time of online submission of application form the candidate must submit the supporting document to substantiate their claim Such candidate (s) must produce original at the time of counselling.
- 4.ix** No student shall be provided two weightage for the purpose of admission under special quota from 4.ii to 4.vii.

**5.** No applicant shall be admitted to the course who has not applied for admission within the notified time period.

**6.** Admitted student's graduated from other University will have to get themselves registered with the L.N. Mithila University within a month of his/her admission, failing with they will not be allowed to appear in CIA/End Semester Examination.

**7.** During the tenure of the course, if it is found that any document/documents or submission made by a student in support of his/her admission to P.G. course is/are forged or fake, his/her admissions shall automatically stand cancelled. The concerned candidate shall be solely responsible for the cancellation of his/her admission and other punitive action/actions.

**8.** The Vice-Chancellor has the absolute right to reject/deny admission to any candidate without assigning any reason if he/she judges that this is in the best interest of the University.

**9.** No candidate shall be allowed to register for any other degree course in the same University or any other University during the same academic session of his/her study of Postgraduate programme.
